

Message & Executive Summary

Every year I write a message and executive summary for the Carolina Union Annual Report where I highlight the great work accomplished over the past year. This year, my message is a tribute to the Carolina Union Professional and Student Staff. I work with an incredible group of people who go above and beyond to provide a safe, welcoming and educational experience for students. We had major challenges this year starting with an armed and dangerous person on campus. We then had an armed person cause a second lockdown in the Carolina Union. The campus, and the staff in the Union, were shaken up, but we are Carolina Strong. The Carolina Union staff did an incredible job securing the building to ensure the safety of everyone in the Union on both days.

This was not a great way to start the academic year. However, the staff continued to come to work, attend training sessions on safety matters, plan events, go to meetings, and get back to business as usual. Every day is an adventure at the Carolina Union where the staff plan and execute events, set up and break down events, attend and develop training programs for both student staff and professional staff, register and advise student organizations, work on budget matters for the Union as well as budgetary matters with student organizations, create graphic design elements for Carolina Union Signature Programs, provide creative services for student organizations, reserve space for over 10,557 events as well as clean and maintain the facility. The staff that work in the Union are hardworking people who genuinely care about the experience that guests have in the Union.

The Union is an aging facility. There are several capital projects that we will be conducting over the next few years. Students and staff love the Union and it is the living room of the campus. This past year, several students and staff toured student unions at other UNC system schools. The goal of these visits was to gather ideas and research for a renovation of the Union or to build a new facility.

As the year progressed, the staff also navigated free speech issues and protests around events focusing on worldwide issues. The Union staff worked on events with high profile speakers, collaborating with the police to ensure the safety of the attendees all while balancing day-to-day activities. This was no easy task. We ended the year with a great deal of protests around campus, which impacted everyone. Commencement was the last major event held on campus and of course many of the Union staff volunteered their time to help with this major milestone event. Protests continued to impact commencement activities but the staff in the Union continued to show up to ensure all events went smoothly.

I thank the staff for working together to get through this challenging year and I look forward to continuing our great work together. You truly are the best! Thank you for all that you have done and will continue to do!

Accomplishments


- Prepared the FY25 Operating Budget for the Carolina Union and Carolina Union Student Organizations (CUSO) for submission to Student Affairs.





Accomplishments

- Commenced the following capital projects:
 - Main elevator upgrade
 - East wing HVAC replacement
 - Great Hall LED lighting upgrade
 - North Wing roof replacement
- Completed the following Capital projects:
 - Refurbished the Carolina Union Art Gallery
 - Replaced the Great Hall accessibility lift
- Completed the transition to a new Union tiered pricing system.

Total Occurrences in 2023 - 2024 (Programs/Events/Meetings)



• Departmental activity increased due to more usage by Student Affairs and relaxing departmental charges, which increased traffic. Union internal increases can be explained by the greater number of activities with more room usage.

Student Life & Leadership

Mission

The mission of Student Life & Leadership is to create an inclusive Carolina community through engagement and intentional educational opportunities.

Accomplishments

- Hosted SmallFest 2023, the student organizations involvement fair, which gained participation from 362 registered student organizations, which is a 10% increase from the previous year, and had 1,056 unique student attendees.
- The Student Orgs Team hosted the Student Organizations Leadership Retreat (SOLR) on Saturday, August 26th; 70 participants (a 10% increase from the previous year) attended the event, which ran from 9am-3pm and included 11 different session topics as well as a resource fair for student org leaders.
- 167 student organizations participated in the Spring Involvement Fair.
- Received a record number of applicants (119) for the NC Fellows program, which is a 35% increase from the previous year.
- Awarded the "Highly Established" Action Plan from All In Democracy.

• Assess efficacy and efficiency of student organization registration process for both new organizations and annual renewals.



Student Life & Leadership by the Numbers





Mission

The mission of CUAB is to create fun, diverse, inclusive, and engaging student programmed events that unite the Carolina community.

Accomplishments

- Collaborated with the Hogan family to host a 100-year Rameses celebration, which drew over 440 attendees.
- Through partnerships with Graduate and Professional Student Government, the Graduate School, and other organizations, successfully attracted over 2,250 graduate attendees to seven graduate-focused events. These events were designed to better meet the needs of graduate and professional students and their families, ensuring a more engaging and accommodating experience for all Tar Heels involved.
- Collaborated with 16 registered student organizations to provide funding for their highcost, special events. This included awarding funds as prizes to the winners of the new SLL Pitch Competition.

2024-25 Goals

- Work to enhance the student experience and increase engagement across campus by providing dynamic and entertaining programs for all UNC-Chapel Hill students.
- Offer committee members opportunities to actively engage with the Carolina Union Board of Directors and the Union as a whole, fostering the development of lifelong leadership skills.
- Appropriately manage and spend student fees.
